



## TAME CLUB FAQ AND ANNUAL REGISTRATION

[TAME Clubs](#) for K-12 students provide a supportive but challenging place to build math, science, and problem-solving skills and to connect to a network of peers, mentors, and future employers.

TAME clubs are inclusive, but recruitment is focused on young women and under-represented minority populations in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math, or STEM. At Clubs, students grades 6-12 prepare to compete in the TAME Math and Science Competitions offered free of cost across the state. They may also participate in other competitive programs like robotics (FIRST, BEST, GEAR, etc.), rocketry programs, Future City Challenge or other events of local interest. Students must be registered with a TAME Club to compete in Math and Science Competitions.
